The purpose of this cash award is to encourage student research on Wisconsin's non-cultivated plants. Any undergraduate or graduate student in a Wisconsin college or university is eligible. The amount of the award is \$500.

Proposals will include:

1. A description of the proposed project, not to exceed five double-spaced pages,
2. A brief resume of the applicant, including mailing address and phone number.
3. For undergraduate students, a letter from a supervising faculty member.
4. Names, addresses, and phone numbers of two additional references.
